place in plastic bag on top of can or enclosure

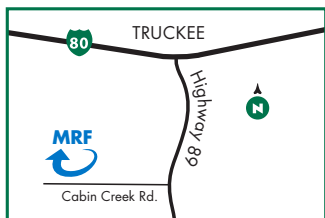
## FREE Hazardous Waste Drop-Off in 2019

## Safe Hauling Restrictions

- Keep products in their original sealed containers, if possible.
- Label materials and sort products by type.
- Place leaking containers in tightly sealed, labeled plastic containers.
- Pack containers upright in cardboard or plastic containers.
- Secure in your car trunk or truck bed.
- Maximum 15 gal. or 125 lbs.
